



Township of Addington Highlands COVID-19 Pandemic – Province Wide Shutdown Media Release

Premier Doug Ford announced on December 21st, 2020 that a Provincial Lockdown will be in effect beginning 12:01am Saturday December 26th, 2020. The Township's Emergency Community Control Group met today, December 23rd, 2020 to review the Provincewide Shutdown measures. As a result, the following modified conditions will apply to municipal services:

Facilities

All Township operated community halls and outdoor rink canteen buildings/change rooms will be closed until further notice.

Building Department

Building Permits are being issued and Building Inspections are being performed with social distancing, by appointment ONLY.

Waste Sites

Normal operating hours will continue. Masks are mandatory where social distancing cannot be maintained. Waste sites attendants will continue to monitor the sites but are unable to handle any items brought into the sites.

Public Works

Road maintenance and snow removal will continue without interruption.

Fire

The Addington Highlands Fire Department will continue to respond to all emergencies.

Public Libraries

Addington Highlands Public Libraries will be closed to the public, however they are offering curbside pickup ONLY, until further notice.

Municipal Office

The Township Office will be closed for the holidays from December 24th, 2020 at 12:00 noon until January 4th, 2021 at 8:30 am.

Due to the Provincial Lockdown the Township Office will be closed to the public effective January 4th, 2021 at 8:30 am until January 25th, 2021 at 8:30 am. Staff will be working regular scheduled hours and can be reached by phone or email.
